## **Professorships**

## Priority research funds and centers

## The Annual Fund

Allocated by university leaders toward the most immediate priorities, Annual Fund investments, from less than \$100 to more than \$100,000, drive academic distinction by bolstering financial aid, augmenting research funding, updating lab equipment, and more.
